- **Individual lessons**
Students are given the opportunity to learn to play a musical instrument one on one with a professional instrument tutor. These lessons are 30 minutes in duration.
- **Duos –Octets**
These lessons are offered for specific instruments. Violin/strings, flute, saxophone, clarinet, percussion and guitar.
- **Ensemble performance classes:**
Specially trained conductors will teach the ensemble classes to students wanting to expand their musical horizons by entering the rewarding new world of ensemble performance!

*Mixed ensemble lessons of 10 students or more are only offered to students already learning an instrument.

Instrumental lessons are paid in advance at the time of enrolment and will be invoiced by the school twice per year. The lessons will be invoiced with the AES and other extra-curricular activities. (Usually, invoices are sent by email mid-October for the 1st semester and mid-March for the 2nd semester)

YMCA Pick up and drop off can be arranged through the individual instrument tutors and YMCA. Please inform the coordinator if this needs to be arranged. Pick up and drop off does take up to 5 minutes off the scheduled 30 minute lesson.

Places are limited ! A waiting list is made once all placements for an instrument or ensemble are full.
